

## **KINSTON AMATEUR RADIO SOCIETY 2 METER NET FORMAT**

**THIS IS (call sign) CALLING THE KINSTON AMATEUR RADIO SOCIETY NET. THIS NET MEETS THE FIRST, THIRD, FOURTH AND FIFTH TUESDAY NIGHTS AT 2000 HOURS LOCAL TIME. THE PURPOSE OF THIS NET IS TO KEEP OUR MEMBERS IN TOUCH AND RELAY INFORMATION BETWEEN CLUB MEETINGS. ALL STATIONS ARE WELCOME TO CHECK IN. YOUR NET CONTROL STATION THIS EVENING IS (your call phonetically). MY NAME IS (your name, QTH IS (location).**

**ARE THERE ANY ANNOUNCEMENTS?**

**WE WILL NOW BEGIN OUR CHECK-INS. STATIONS ARE REQUESTED TO CHECK INTO THE NET ALPHABETICALLY BASED ON THE FIRST LETTER OF THEIR CALL SUFFIX AS REQUESTED BY YOUR NET CONTROL STATION (give your call again).**

**ASK FOR YL'S, XYL'S AND MOBILES**

**STATIONS ALPHA THROUGH KILO -- CALL (your call)**

**STATIONS LIMA THROUGH SIERRA -- CALL (your call)**

**STATIONS TANGO THROUGH ZULU -- CALL (your call)**

**(NOTE: recognize each station following a pause in the check-ins for each grouping.**

**Example: NET CONTROL RECOGNIZES STATIONS W9EF, N4JGD  
KW4LM.**

**CALL FOR LATE CHECK-INS FOLLOWING YOUR TANGO --  
ZULU CALL.**

**THIS IS (your call) CLOSING THE FORMAL PORTION OF THE NET. WE WILL NOW ENTERTAIN THE RAG CHEWS. (Now call for rag chews in the order in which they checked in -- this is the fun part, don't forget your own rag chew).**

**ARE THERE ANY LATE CHECK-INS FOR THE KINSTON AMATEUR RADIO SOCIETY NET? IF SO, PLEASE CALL (your call).**

**THIS IS (your call) THANKING EACH OF YOU FOR YOUR PARTICIPATION THIS EVENING. TOTAL CHECK-INS FOR TONIGHT IS ( ). PLEASE CHECK IN WITH US ON OUR NEXT SCHEDULE NET. TONIGHT'S NET IS CLOSE AT (hour and minute) and (your call) IS RETURNING THE W4OIX REPEATER BACK TO NORMAL USE. 73.**

**NOTE: PLEASE USE THE STANDARD ITU PHONETIC ALPHABET DURING THIS NET AND OTHER RADIO TRANSMISSIONS.**
